2020 A Year for Helping Out in the Bush

For much of the 55 years we have been providing support in the bush the main reason for families needing our help, in addition to their isolation, has been severe and prolonged droughts.

This year, there have been additional difficulties for country people with major bushfires and now the COVID-19 lockdown.

At the end of 2019 the BCEF Board approved a 150% increase in our Rural Secondary Boarding Bursaries program up to a maximum of \$2,500 per student.

While 2020 has been disastrous with drought, bushfires and COVID-19, the Foundation has received incredible support to assist young people living in the bush.



We have been extremely fortunate to have received financial assistance from the Commonwealth Bank's Drought Relief Fund and the Thyne Reid Foundation to help us support our bursary program this year.

Marketing Activities

The Board has identified that many isolated and disadvantaged families are not aware of the assistance they can receive from the BCEF, similar charitable organisations and government. This year we embarked on an advertising and marketing campaign to let people in the bush know about our support. BCEF Director, Duncan Gay, was interviewed on the ABC Country Hour in the Riverina while Richard Dougan was interviewed

on the ABC Country Hour, Dubbo, and spoke to the ABC's Macca on a Sunday Morning. He also joined Natalie Peters and Matt Wilton on the 2GB podcast rural/agriculture show called "Further Afield". In addition, we advertised in The Land Newspaper on Thursday, 20th February 2020.

Rural Secondary School Boarding Bursaries Program

The severity of the drought and bushfires and the impact of COVID-19, coupled with the increased value of our bursaries and our marketing campaign have resulted in BCEF receiving 132 applications for support.

After detailed assessment of these applications we have approved 81 bursaries in 2020 with a few still waiting for completion of documentation requirements at a total cost of around \$160,000. These bursaries will support young people from 50 families, with the students attending 15 boarding schools throughout country NSW including the following.

We have raised the bar in 2020 and will need to at least maintain that support in 2021, or increase it, as the economic effects of the drought, bushfires and COVID-19 will be with us for many years.

University Scholarships Program

We maintain a commitment for four scholarships at Charles Sturt University with two students studying Veterinary Science at the Wagga Wagga campus. A further two students are studying Early Childhood and Primary Teaching at the Dubbo and Bathurst campuses. Our scholars perform very well with high Grade Point Averages.

This year we had 45 applications for one scholarship which was ultimately awarded to Alex Farquhar to study Vet Science at the CSU Wagga Campus. Alex comes from Manilla near Tamworth and attended Calrossy Anglican School and Tamworth High. He is currently learning online and looking forward to living on campus when the universities re-open.

These scholarships are awarded for 3 years for a total value of \$10,000 each.

Each year the BCEF selection panel is privileged to interview outstanding candidates for the BCEF CSU Scholarship and would be delighted to award further scholarships at CSU, University of New England and University of Newcastle, if funds were available. This would help mitigate the severe financial hardship

experienced by many country students from isolated areas as they undertake tertiary studies.

While this has been a challenging year for the BCEF Board and our Education, Scholarships and Bursaries Committee due to the large number of Rural Boarding Bursary applications, the available funding has provided an outstanding result in helping families to educate their children at Rural Boarding Schools.

BCEF and Order of St Lazarus of Jerusalem CSU Scholar 2019 – Hayley Grimson

Our 2019 CSU Scholarships were supported by the Military and Hospitaller Order of St Lazarus of Jerusalem and BNP Paribas. To inform these organisations about the benefit and impact of our scholarships Hayley Grimson was asked to travel to Sydney from Dubbo to make a presentation to the BNP Paribas Bank's Environment Group. She was also asked to attend the Military and Hospitaller Order of St Lazarus of Jerusalem Annual Patronal Church Service and Dinner at St John's College, Sydney University.

Her presentation at both functions provided the background to her studying Early Childhood and Primary Teaching and how critical it was for her to be the beneficiary of BCEF's support, which was extremely well received.

As we all know, for those living remotely in NSW (across the other side of the 'Sandstone Curtain'), 2019/20 has had its challenges, firstly with the long-term drought, then the unprecedented bushfires and finally a pandemic.

Although the long-term Bureau of Meteorology forecast is looking reasonably positive in the short term, a global recession, fear of a second wave COVID-19 and uncertainty around international export markets for Australian agricultural commodities is certainly front of mind to all our stakeholders.

We are committed to assisting the many families who are struggling with this diverse range of challenges, however, we can only continue whilst we have financial help from our very generous benefactors.

Board Meetings

The Board has met regularly throughout the year to manage the affairs of the BCEF and to provide support for the bush as much as possible.

There have been no changes to the composition of the Board since our last communication.

Financial Report

Despite the economic impact of the pandemic, donations of \$169,000 were received in the 9 month period to 31 March 2020. We have paid or committed to using these donations to fund secondary school bursaries and university scholarships to over 80 students over the ensuing 12 months, subject to boarding closures due to COVID-19. Further applications for assistance are currently being assessed.

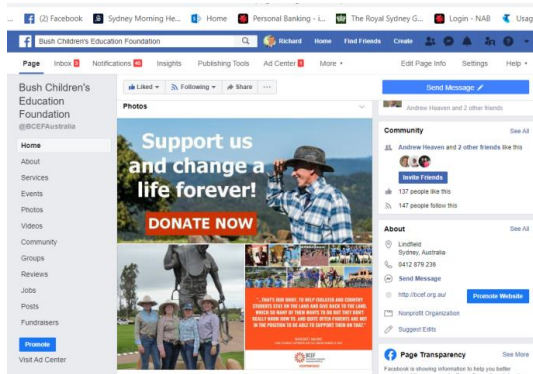
